

Document has been temporarily removed and is under review

The submissions of the Nawrot family dated April 18, 2013 and filed with the Canadian Transportation Agency have been temporarily removed at the request of Sunwing Airlines (see next page).

It is our position that the submissions in question are privileged as they have been made in the course of a proceeding before a quasi-judicial body; moreover, we fail to find anything defamatory in said submissions.

However, as a gesture of goodwill and out of abundance of caution to avoid any possible harm or damage, we have temporarily removed the document in question, and will be asking Sunwing Airlines to identify the allegedly false and/or defamatory portions of the document.

After review of Sunwing Airlines' response and concerns, we will determine whether the document is to be removed permanently.

Words in these submissions are false and defamatory and have caused and continue to cause Sunwing Airlines Inc. damage to its reputation.

Pursuant to the decision of the CTA dated April 19, 2013 these submissions are not part of the CTA record.

Accordingly, the defamatory statements therein do not attract privilege and in any event, their continued publication is done with malice.

I have been instructed by Sunwing Airlines Inc. to demand that you <u>immediately</u> remove the submissions from the website, from anywhere else you may have caused them to be published and cease and desist from any further publication.

Should you fail to remove the submissions <u>immediately</u>, Sunwing Airlines Inc. will seek damages from you for defamation by way of court action.

Govern yourselves accordingly.
