## Re: Air Passenger Rights v Canadian Transportation Agency Court File No.: A-102-20

We are writing to withdraw our request for Directions from the Court.

Our request for Directions was prompted by two developments; (a) the Applicant's expressed intention to file new evidence after cross-examination of the Respondent's affiant and (b) the Applicant's request to amend the existing timeline to cross-examine the Respondent's affiant without providing the opportunity to both parties to address the transcript in submissions.

In its letter dated April 30, 2020, submitted following the request for Directions, the Applicant indicated that it was no longer seeking to file additional evidence.

In its letter submitted to the Court earlier today, the Applicant now indicates that it does not wish to cross-examine the Agency's affiant.
