This letter is in reply to the Applicant's letter dated July 29, 2022. Please bring this letter to Gleason J.A's attention.

After reading the Applicant's response, it seems that some clarification in reply is required. The Agency is not "unilaterally" redacting the Twitter and Info email account materials or seeking "a blank cheque". The Agency has brought a motion per Rule 151 in the manner set out by the Court in the July 19, 2022 Order. That motion was accompanied by a request for an extension so that Agency staff can complete a review of the material and redact the information that the Agency believes should be kept confidential while indicating the reasons for which material has been redacted. Once this work is complete, the Agency has every intent of providing the Court with an unredacted copy of the materials.
