RE: Air Passenger Rights v. AGC and CTA (A-102-20)

We are counsel for the Applicant. Please bring this letter to Gleason J.A.'s attention. Her Ladyship is seized of all pre-hearing issues, pursuant to the Order of July 19, 2022. Please accept this letter as an informal motion to amend the scheduling order dated September 2, 2022, pursuant to para. 2 of that order. The amendment below is proposed after consultation and agreement by all parties, including the CTA.
