With respect to the Appellant's letter dated December 24, 2013, and to assist the Court in its consideration of the Appellant's request, the Respondent would like to clarify that it is not alleging that the clause-by-clause for Bill C-14 formed part of the record that was before Parliament when it passed the Act.

Instead, the Respondent refers to the clause-by-clause for the Court's consideration, on the basis that documents like a clause-by-clause have been regarded by the courts as a component of the contextual analysis of legislation.
