

Re: Gábor Lukács v. Canadian Transportation Agency Federal Court of Appeal File No.: A-279-13 Request for recorded hearing

The hearing of the above-noted appeal is set for January 29, 2014. A unique feature of the present appeal is that it is an appeal from a statutory instrument rather than from a decision, and there is also a substantial factual dispute as to the Disputed Document that will be addressed at the hearing pursuant to the Direction of the Honourable Court dated December 23, 2013. Thus, the Honourable Court will likely hear not only legal arguments, but also factual representations with respect to the Disputed Document.

As outlined in my letter of December 30, 2013, the Canadian Transportation Agency has been making contradictory factual representations with respect to the Disputed Document. Consequently, the factual representations made at the hearing of the appeal are of great importance and relevance should either party seek leave to appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada.

Therefore, I am writing to request that the hearing of the appeal be recorded, so that a transcript of the hearing will be available if necessary.
